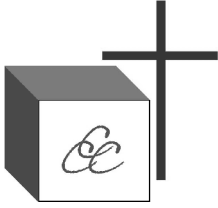

Sessions Descriptions

Archery

This class is designed to teach youth how to shoot a bow and arrow as well as safety precautions required in the sport. Kids will be making their own bow and arrows (blunt tips) with easy to assemble materials that will be provided.

Arts & Crafts

We will be using clay pots to make amazing candy dishes in the shape of animals and famous people. We will paint, cut, glue and decorate our way to colorful and eye-catching dishes that hold your favorite candies!

Cake Decorating

Participants in this class will be introduced to decorating techniques, with the opportunity to decorate cupcakes and a cake. Final projects will be on display during the parent expo. Kids can also enjoy decorating at home with the piping kit and apron given to this class

Magnetic Mayhem

Come check out all the exciting experiments you can do with magnets. Explore how magnets attract, repel, and how they are used. Everyday will be filled with experiments and demonstrations. Can a liquid be magnetic? Can we make magnets float? Campers will take home a magnet set.

Playground Paradise

School may be out for the summer but, we can still have fun with classic playground games. We'll play a new game each day including kick ball and four square.

Walk on the Wild Side

Learn the basics of safety and survival in the wilderness in this nature-based class. Children will learn "do's and don'ts" for hiking, get help identifying some of Michigan's flora and fauna, gain good tips on keeping safe on our numerous trails. Basics for enjoying time in our great God-given outdoors are addressed, with hands-on learning, and even a "shakedown hike", weather permitting.

Woodshop

Get ready to build your own racing boat from pine wood. Students will build, glue, stain and paint a boat they can use over and over again. We will spend two days building our boats and the last day having boat races. Rev up your rubber band powered boats and get ready for some fun!
